It was noted that the application is outside of the Conservation Area. First impressions are that this application seems to be for a very large extension although lacking in detail. In the absence of a Design and Access Statement the committee feels this is overdevelopment. With UPVC materials being used it also does not enhance the street scene. It was agreed by all to object to the application on the basis that in the absence of a Design and Access Statement the application is overdevelopment.

Cllr Windell explained that on first reading there needs to be some clarifications on the following; (1) Article 4 = vital to be retained (i.e. to prevent some permitted development rights), (2) no mention of the Neighbourhood Plan in the document, (3) Geographical area – how chosen? And (4) what happens about parish boundary going over to Walberswick – where does our Neighbourhood Plan fit in? Where does Walberswick Neighbourhood Plan fit in? See especially first pages 10-12.
