

Southwold Enterprise Hub Construction Works – new electricity supply – w/c 15th May 2023.

In respect of the UKPN new electrical supply works being carried out on behalf of Southwold Town Council at the site on the corner of Station Road and Blyth Road.

The new mains supply works by UKPN will be commencing on Monday 15th May. Their highway permit has been granted for the duration of their works scheduled to finish on the 31st May or sooner if possible. We have tried to influence the UKPN works but due to the scope of their works they are unable to streamline their works.

UKPN have stated that their work scheduled is to bring the new supply from Station Road across Blyth Road and entering the site along Blyth Road. A traffic management system – 4 way lights (2 situated in Station Road, 1 in Pier Avenue and 1 in Blyth Road) will be used. The car parking bays at the front of the businesses will be suspended for the duration of the works.

The contractors have met with UKPN on site and it was again discussed regarding the length of their works. They will endeavour to complete their works and clear away in readiness for the Whitsun Bank holiday weekend. If for any reason their works are not complete by the Bank holiday weekend we have arranged for the 4 way traffic management to be pulled back to allow the suspended parking bays to be made available.

If the works do not take place over the weekends the traffic management will be disengaged to allow a free movement of traffic into and out of the town.

We have been advised that the use of the Millennium car park is available for business owners, employees and visitors. This has parking for approx. 50+ vehicles.
