5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 4 May 2023** between the hours of **7am and 10pm**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **midnight** on **Monday, 17 April 2023**. Applications can be made online : www.gov.uk/registertovote
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal and postal proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm** on **Tuesday, 18 April 2023**.
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm** on **Tuesday, 25 April 2023** Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate
9. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm** on **Tuesday, 25 April 2023**.
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm** on **Thursday, 4 May 2023**.
