Southwold Rugby continues to flourish and our teams continue to grow in stature and reputation beyond Eastern Counties. The 1st XV have just had a fantastic season culminating in a well deserved promotion to London Division 2. This is the highest level in the club's 50 year history and we will be playing the likes of Norwich and Ipswich this season.

Throughout the club our squads are also growing in numbers and we are no longer “the little club by the seaside”. We now have over 350 members and field 6 Minis teams (U7s-U12s), 4 Youth teams (U13s-U16s), a Colts team (U18s), an U21s team, a Ladies team and 2 Men’s teams.
